# **Requesting Help for Those with Hearing Loss**

By Sharon Hendricks, published in the Oklahoman newspaper June 2, 2019 It's been a little over a year since the Civic Center installed a hearing loop (yes, all 2,500 seats!) to accommodate those of us with hearing loss. What a blessing this has been, enriching our lives and allowing us to enjoy this venue by actually hearing what is on stage! Many thanks to the Civic Center for taking this step in complying with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Why, then, don't other venues step up to the need to provide adequate hearing access to their public facilities? Lyric Theatre, Oklahoma City University, Metropolitan Library and churches, we need your support. In addition, audiologists must make sure hearing aids, cochlear implants, assistive listening devices, etc., are equipped with a telecoil (T-coil) so their clients can enjoy the benefits of the hearing loop.

Nearly all public venues have ramps to aid those who are physically disabled and Braille for the blind, but what about those of us who have an invisible disability? It's time to act and comply with the ADA.

They stopped by a theater which offered captioning devices. Unfortunately, these systems are underused by those of us who could benefit from the hearing help most and often do not work correctly. We must make managers aware of our needs and take the time to make them aware of any problems with their systems. Ron did just that by emailing the theater's manager when he returned home.

This is a perfect example of hearing SELF-ADVOCACY. If each of us connected with our favorite venues in a similar way, just imagine how quickly we could make Oklahoma more hearing accessible.
