
The Central Oklahoma Hearing Loss Association Chapter has several amazing events coming up that you can participate in!



Cost of the movie: \$6.75 (discounted rate)



Endowment Tip #5

The most tax efficient way to leave a charitable gift from your estate is through a retirement account.

By naming the Central Oklahoma Chapter, Hearing Loss Association as one of the beneficiaries of your retirement plan, the gift will be tax-free.

If you are subject to estate tax, your estate will also receive a charitable deduction to offset potential liabilities. Simply request a beneficiary designation form from your retirement plan administrator and list the Central Oklahoma Chapter, Hearing Loss Association as a primary or contingent beneficiary. Make sure you communicate your intent of a gift to the executor of your estate as well as to the Central Oklahoma Chapter, Hearing Loss Association.
